

Bridgestone 4x4 Club Challenge 2016

Overview

The Bridgestone 4x4 club challenge will be starting in February with four qualifying rounds all hosted at the Rhino Park Facility. This year the focus is on the standard vehicles with limited changes to make the playing fields fair and most of important a family fun weekend away and safe event.

We only have a limited space of 200 vehicles for the qualifying rounds hosted over four dates in February and March. After the qualifying Rounds the top 6 teams per club * will proceed to the elimination rounds made up of four events, taking place in May July September and November, these events will be hosted within 250km from JHB and will be in the North, East, South and West of JHB.

We will continue to use the format of Short wheel base and Long Wheel Base class as well as a standard** and Non Standard. ***

The events will comprise of ten obstacles and will have two options of driving and scoring points one being 100 points and the other being 75 points max, the standard point system will remain in place, the course will also be set up to accommodate a scenic route of 30 to 40 km, creating a out drive combined with obstacles, GPS device is not essential as hand books and road markers will be provided, but it could be handy to have. We will also focus on the environmental prizes for the event and all everyone will stand a chance to win the prize

There will be a once off fee of R300 per vehicle on the day of the event, once you qualify to represent your club, there won't be any further entry fee payable. At all elimination rounds the accommodation fees (Camping) will be covered from the Friday till the Sunday to encourage the event as a family fun weekend away.

The competitors will also accumulate points as they proceed through the four rounds in May, July, September and November. Each competitor will receive custom made medals for each event during the four elimination rounds. The qualifying rounds will see the top ten receive prizes, first place being a Bridgestone tyre voucher to the value of R10 000 and smaller secondary prizes, from co sponsors Opposite Lock.

The club member must please lease with the respective club chairpersons to keep control of who is entering on which date. Please clubs must send me the completed entry forms by no later than the 29th January 2016.

The club with the most entries will also receive a cash prize after the elimination rounds; the clubs with the highest accumulated points over the elimination rounds will also walk away with a R20 000 cash Voucher from Bridgestone.

Standard Vehicle **

This is a vehicle that is showroom condition as per OEM manufacturer and limited to the following allowable changes:

- Aftermarket bumper, Bulbar, protection plates, rock sliders and cosmetic accessories
- After market suspension limited to maximum height of 2 inch
- Tyre size not exceeding a diameter of 820mm (33")

The vehicle must have its original manufacture spec engine, drive chain and transmission.

Non Standard Vehicle ***

This is a vehicle that is showroom condition as per OEM manufacturer and limited to the following allowable changes:

- Aftermarket bumper, Bulbar, protection plates, rock sliders and cosmetic accessories
- After market suspension limited to maximum height of 2 inch
- Tyre size not exceeding a diameter of 820mm (33")
- **Aftermarket traction aids (locker,diff Lock, limited slip diff) all traction aids the vehicle did not come out with**

The vehicle must have its original manufacture spec engine, drive chain and transmission.

Club *

The club will only be seen as a club if there is a minimum of 10 Entries under the club during the four qualifying rounds. This will entitle the club to qualify for a total of 6 team members to proceed into the elimination rounds as well as stand a chance to win the R20000 cash voucher.

Clubs failing to make the minimum of ten entries will be seen as individual competitor and will be selected on the highest scores achieved over the qualifying rounds. The focus will be on the standard vehicle class as a first option.

We would also like to encourage women driver teams to run a class of their own, so please let's encourage this.

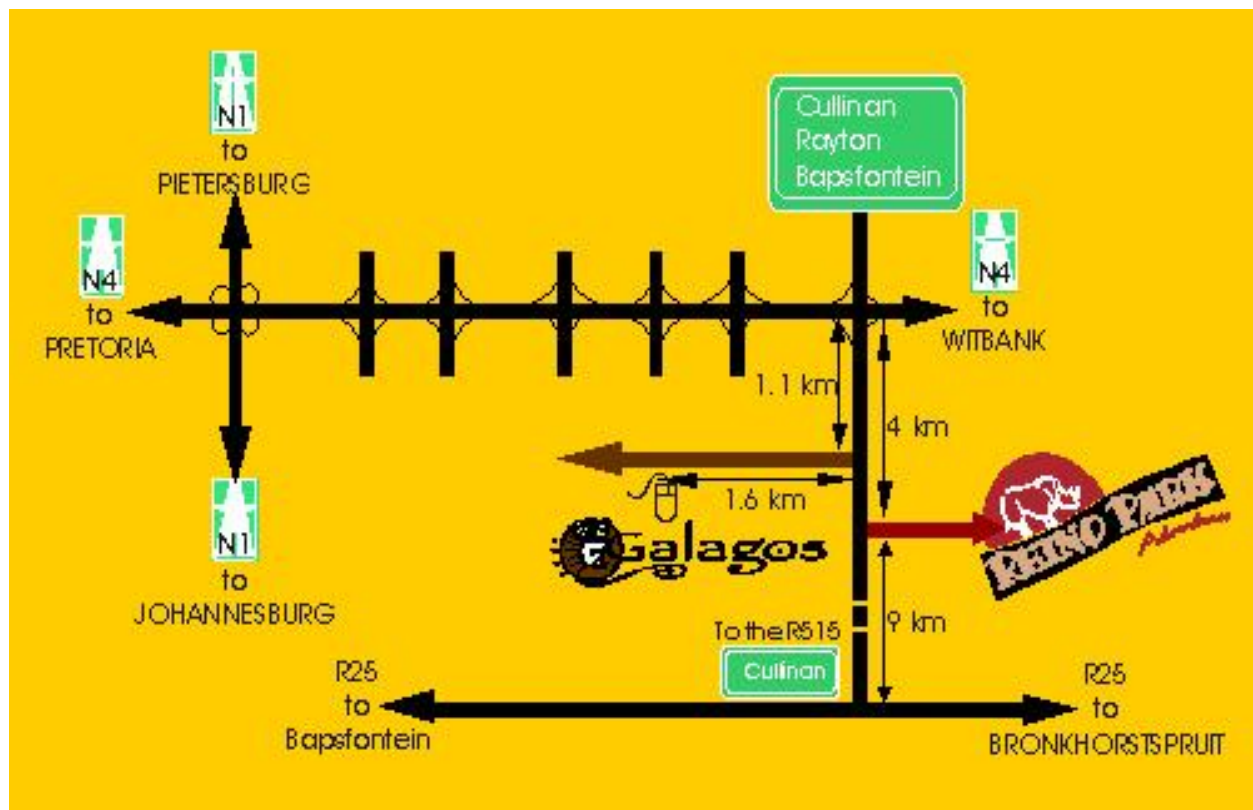
